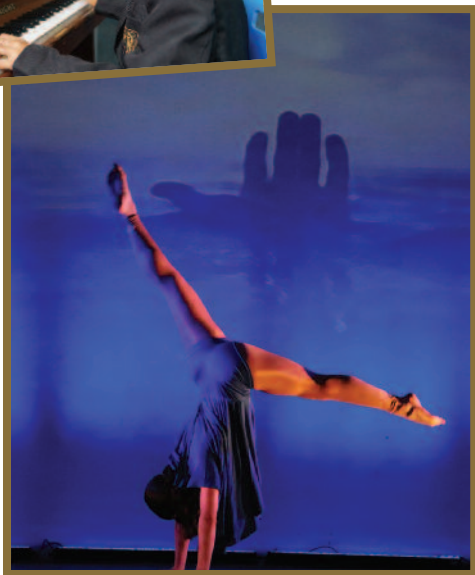
Throughout their journey at Bassingbourn Village College, our students' confidence grows as well as their ability and this is witnessed through a number of performances which showcase their achievements.
